Linda H. opened the meeting with the Serenity Prayer at 7:00 p.m. Step 1 read by Karen C. First Tradition and First Concept read by Linda Mc.

- Minutes and Treasurer's Report read by Linda H. Different starting because of B.O.A. charging monthly.
- January 29th: Garage Sale. Judy asked about volunteers working garage sale.
- Traditions Workshop, February 19th, 9a.m. to 3p.m. at Friendship United Methodist Church. Flyers distributed.
- March 5th Mardi Gras party, 6p.m. to 10p.m.; discussion - Betsey voiced objection to the entrance fee of \$10 single and \$15 couple as discriminatory to singles.
